



## 6.4 Children's Vaccination Complete Details

A list of common Vaccines with their purpose, recommended schedules and some notable side effects are mentioned below:

- Disease: Coronavirus Vaccine Name: COVID-19 Schedule: 1 dose ( between 2-12 years of age) Side effects: Sore arms or fevers.
- Disease: Influenza Vaccine Name: Flu Schedule: 1 or 2 doses annually ( between 2-12 years of age) Side effects: Mild soreness or redness at the injection site, low-grade fever, fatigue, and muscle aches.
- Disease: Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis
   Vaccine Name: Tdap
   Schedule: 1 dose annually ( between 11-12 years of age)
   Side effects: Soreness, redness, or swelling at the injection site, mild fever, fussiness.
- Disease: Human papillomavirus (Cervical cancer) Vaccine Name: HPV Schedule: 1 dose annually ( between 11-12 years of age) Side effects: Pain at the injection site, dizziness, fainting.
- Disease: Meningococcal Vaccine Name: Men ACWY Schedule: 1 dose annually ( between 11-12 years of age) Side effects: redness, hardening and itching at the injection site, a high temperature (above 38C), headache, feeling sick (nausea) and tiredness (fatigue).

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
